Aune, who is in his 22nd year as conductor of the Gustavus Choir. In its 84 year choral history, the a cappella ensemble has performed nationally and internationally, including for the King and Queen of Sweden. Gustavus Adolphus College, founded in 1862, is a highly selective, private, liberal arts college of recognized academic excellence with a student body of 2,500. The college values its Lutheran and Swedish heritage and is guided by five core values: excellence, community, justice, service, and faith. A freewill offering will be taken.
