

#### PASTOR'S PAGES . . .

The author of Ecclesiastes says, "There is a time for every matter under heaven." This scripture is truly a blessing in times of pastoral transition. In times of transition, there is so much uncertainty in the church, and perhaps even a bit of anxiety. The natural instinct is to work quickly to call (many even say hire) a new Pastor. But God invites us to slow down a bit to allow the Holy Spirit to work in God's time to call the Pastor with the gifts that are needed to shepherd the Church. As I shared in the sermon on my first Sunday, God was with Shepherd of the Glades from the time Pastor Doug announced his retirement to the time I accepted the call. And God continues to be with us as we journey together in our faith journey. I invite you to reflect on my experience of the many ways God was and is present in the call process.



There is a time for every matter under heaven. As I discerned my call to Shepherd of the Glades, there was a time for me to let go of the familiar and comfortable. What I experienced as I trusted in God and God's timing was an incredible thing. Through prayer, I determined God was calling me to serve Shepherd of the Glades. That was the easy part. There was much to do before our arrival. First, there came a time for my family to celebrate the marriage of one of our children. It was a beautiful time of celebration. Then came a time to spend a week with boy scouts at camp in northern Minnesota. This was a great time to enjoy with Abraham and spend a lot of time in prayer about the many changes that were about to happen. It was also time to plan our move. It meant leaving behind all our non-essential "stuff." Some of you have experienced this, so you understand the challenges that come with such a big move. But God was with us through it all. We felt the love and prayers of the members of Shepherd of the Glades even when we became frustrated. Then it was time to arrive and move into our new home ... or not. God had other plans. Our closing took two days longer than we had planned. But God was with us in those two days as we lived in a time of uncertainty about when we could move in to our new home.
