1 Corinthians 13:4-7 says, "Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends." Love is not easy, but we are called to love one another as Christ has loved us.


YOU ARE INVITED . . .

SHEPHERD OF THE GLADES LUTHERAN CHURCH January 11, 2022, COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

A motion to approve the minutes of the last Council meeting as written, with a correction of adding three guests. Guests in attendance were Elaine Sime, Brad Caulder and John Sherman. Motion was then made, seconded, and passed.

Pastor's report: Pastor Jeff reported that he has had ZOOM meetings with East Naples Ministerial group and personal spiritual direction meetings. He has attended weekly staff meetings and met with the Property Committee re: sanctuary lighting and lighting in Hanson Hall; fire detection alarm system; and the Finance Committee regarding 2022 budget. Pastor has met with the Pastors of both the Spanish and Haitian churches. He has been visiting and praying with members that have been hospitalized or sick, and he has been doing homebound communions. Pastor felt Christmas eve services were well attended. Pastor officiated at a non-member wedding off Church property, and the wedded couple made a sizable donation to the church. Hanson Hall continues to be utilized by Iglesia Conexion United Methodist Church, Haitian Baptist Church, Bone Builders, AA Groups, HOA neighborhood groups and our Sew-Sews. We continue to follow CDC guidelines and are monitoring local Covid cases. Pastor suggests that the church task force reconvene due to the fact that Covid cases are on the rise.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Tidmore reported, that the Truist investment account shows an increase as of December 31, 2021. Bob continues to work with the finance committee on the 2022 approved budget.

Both the Pastor's and Treasurer's reports were motioned for approval, seconded, and passed.

Committee reports:

Endowment – Balance in Ministry Growth Fund shows an increase as of December 2021.

Parish Relations – Mutual Ministry is looking to add two new members in 2022.

<u>Property</u> – committee still working on getting new lights in the Sanctuary and Hanson Hall. <u>Education</u> – Pastor Ungs will provide a Bible study class every Wednesday morning at 10:00 a.m. in the church courtyard. Elaine Sima will have a Women's Bible study the first Friday of each month at 10:00 a.m. in the choir room.

<u>Fellowship</u> – Committee members working on "Welcome Back Luncheon" and the "Chili Cookoff". * <u>Stewardship</u> – On Sunday, January 23rd the committee will offer a "Ministry Fair". The purpose of the fair is to share with the congregation what each committee does and to encourage them to join. Evangelism- The "Giving Tree" and "Christmas Meal" were a wonderful success. Local Mission- Donated food was delivered to St. Matthews in Naples.

Council meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m. with closing prayer by Pastor Jeff.


Next meeting will be February 8, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., with devotions by Charlotte Wahlig.
