PASTOR'S PAGES . . .

"For everything there is a season and a time for every matter under heaven:" (Ecclesiastes 3:1)

My call to Shepherd of the Glades began August 1, 2019. That means that I have served as your Pastor for 3 years. I guess I am not your "new Pastor" any more. When I was in seminary, there was an unwritten rule that was shared with future pastors; that you should not change anything in a congregation for the first 3 years. The biggest change that I had planned was to say, "Good Morning Church!", before every worship service. But even if I wanted to keep things the same for my first three years here, it would not have been possible with Covid.

Change is inevitable. In three years, we have said farewell to many saints, and we have been blessed to receive many new members. As Ecclesiastes writes, there is a time to be born and experience new life, and there is a time to say farewell to those we love who die.



These changes are a normal part of the life of the ebb and flow of a congregation. But with Covid, we introduced some changes to worship when we could no longer meet in person. Some of those changes remain in place. Some of these changes are controversial because part of our instinct is to return to what was once considered normal. As your Pastor, I have made some decisions that other ELCA Pastors and Bishops did not agree with. Many still do not agree with having individual communion available for both those who attend worship in person and those who remain home for personal safety reasons. If you want to know why I continue offering communion this way, I will be happy to discuss it with you. The abbreviated reason is that I am called to administer Word and Sacrament to those who wish to receive. I believe Jesus is truly present in, with, and under the elements when they are consecrated. There are people who can be virtually present during worship and join us who otherwise may not be able to be in communion with the congregation when they receive the sacrament. Therefore, I will continue this relatively new practice during worship for some time.

Another change that people have questions about is why we continue to have online services when we can gather in person. Some members believe that more people would return to "in person worship" if we did not have online services. The short answer is that we have people who are immunocompromised and elderly who are shut-ins who truly enjoy watching online and feel connected to the congregation in ways they otherwise could not. The longer answer is that we are reaching out to as many people on a weekly basis online as we are in person. We are called to "go" and proclaim the Gospel, and not just fill the church pews. Some who have gotten Covid and are susceptible to getting it again have told me they are not comfortable returning to "in person worship" because they notice that almost no one wears a mask during worship. Others who are now watching regularly have not been members of a church and have not attended a church for a very long time because of their experience in the church, but they are hungry for God's Word and happy to have access to worship. Some of our seasonal members have commented that they can remain connected even while they are away. There are many valid reasons we continue to offer online worship and bible study. Between in person and online attendance, our average weekly attendance and giving has increased over the summer.

Finally, another big change is renting Hanson Hall to two mission congregations. It is my hope that Shepherd of the Glades can continue experiencing the joy of partnering with these two vibrant new mission congregations. There is a time for every matter under heaven. And there is no better time than now to reach out to as many people as we can with the Good News of Jesus Christ. We are living out our mission statement of, "Transforming lives through the Living Word of God." I guess I can no longer refer to myself as the "new Pastor" at Shepherd of the

Glades after three years. The time has gone quickly and I am blessed to serve as your Pastor. Thank you for putting up with some pretty big changes the first three years of my ministry. I guess sometimes you just have to let go of unwritten and unspoken rules and let the Holy Spirit get to work!
