**SHEPHERD OF THE GLADES
LUTHERAN CHURCH**

“For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for our sakes he became poor so that you through his poverty might become rich.”
(1 Corinthians 8-9)

This seems like an odd Bible verse about which to write a Thanksgiving article. However, legend has it that this very verse inspired a hymn writer to compose a very well known Christian Hymn, *“Give Thanks with a Grateful Heart.”* This hymn is not like many of the other songs we sing in church because this particular hymn was not written and composed until 1978. Although this hymn has erroneously been credited to Don Moen in some places, the correct author and composer of this famous hymn is Henry Smith. The story behind the hymn is what makes it worth sharing as we celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday.



Henry Smith graduated from Seminary in 1978. While in seminary and after he graduated, Smith suffered from a degenerative eye condition that would eventually leave him blind. Unfortunately, Smith was unable to get a call to serve a church. Yet even with the challenges he faced with his degenerative eye condition and inability to land a job, he never gave up hope or his faith in Christ. While attending a church in Williamsburg, Virginia, Smith’s pastor shared the Bible verse from 1 Corinthians, written at the beginning of this article. Smith realized how Jesus made himself poor just to make others rich through him. Finding hope in the scripture, Smith crafted this song of thanksgiving and trust. He later called it *“Give Thanks with a Grateful Heart.”* Smith started performing the song in church, and an American military officer happened to attend worship one Sunday when Smith was singing this hymn. The officer took the song with him to Germany where he and his wife introduced the song to their congregation. Soon the hymn was being played and sung throughout all of Europe where it became a standard hymn. In 1986, the hymn caught the attention of Integrity Music who published the hymn under an unknown author. An American songwriter, Don Moen, known for praise music picked up the hymn and released the song on his *“Give Thanks”* album. Thus, he was given credit for this hymn. Eventually, Smith learned that his song had been published and notified Integrity Music that he was the author. Integrity Music gave the rights to the song to Smith and over 50 other recording studios produced the hymn. While attending a concert of Don Moen, Smith heard his hymn sung in Russian and it is said that he was overcome with joy and cried. Henry Smith composed over 300 hymns that remain unpublished. *“Give Thanks”* is the only hymn that received international recognition. With the incredible success of *“Give Thanks (With a Grateful Heart),”* it became Hosanna! Music’s bestselling release, selling more than one million copies around the world. Church congregations around the world favorably received the song, and it is now recognized as one of the most popular contemporary hymns.

PASTOR'S PAGES . . .

Rather than wallow in self pity and anger over his impending blindness and inability to receive a call to the church, Henry Smith turned to the Word of God for encouragement and inspiration. His legacy lives on through this single hymn. As we celebrate the holiday of Thanksgiving, I invite you to reflect on how you respond to difficult times. Do you complain and focus on what is not going well in your life, or do you give God thanks, with a grateful heart for the many riches Christ has given you? Have a blessed Thanksgiving, and give God thanks for all that God has done for you.

COUNCIL CORNER . . .

October 12, 2021 COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

A motion to approve the minutes of the last Council meeting as written was made, seconded, and passed.

Pastor's report: Pastor Jeff reported that he has had ZOOM meetings with East Naples Ministerial group, personal spiritual direction meetings, and Caloosa Conference. He has attended weekly staff meetings and met with the Property Committee and the Mutual Ministry Team. Pastor has met with the Pastors of both the Spanish and Haitian churches. He has been visiting and praying with members that have been hospitalized or sick, and he has been doing homebound communions. Memorial service for Carol Lyberg is scheduled for Saturday, October 30th at 11:00 a.m. with luncheon to follow. Synod Assembly will be online October 15-16th. Ann and Paul Hashagen will join Pastor Jeff and participate together and vote online. Hanson Hall continues to be utilized by Iglesia Conexion United Methodist Church, Haitian Baptist Church, Bone Builders, AA Groups, HOA neighborhood groups and our Sew-Sews. We continue to follow CDC guidelines and are monitoring local Covid cases. Masks continue to be recommended during worship. It is my hope that October 31st (Reformation Sunday) we will be able to return to communion at the railing. Pastor encouraged the Council liaisons to help their committees' set goals for the upcoming year and discuss ways these goals can be reached. Thank you to Pastor Tara McGraw for filling in for Pastor during his time away for a family funeral. Pastor will be gone from October 20-27th.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Tidmore stated that the BB&T account showed a decrease for the month of September but continues to show an increase YTD. The PPP loan due in October 2021 has been forgiven. Finance committee continues to meet with the chairman of each committee to determine their needs for the upcoming year. The Finance Committee will then present Council with a 2022 budget at the November meeting.

Both the Pastor's and Treasurer's reports were motioned for approval, seconded, and passed.

Committee reports:

Endowment – Balance in ELCA Endowment Account shows an increase as of September 30, 2021.

Parish Relations – No report

Property - Doug Walck reported that the equipment needed for the lighting modules & the new electrical beam in the Sanctuary is on backorder. Doug will check on the fire safety monitoring when work on the beam is completed.

Education – Pastor Ungs is providing a Bible study class every Thursday at 3:00 p.m. The church is selling calendars again this year as a fund raiser for education.

Fellowship – Penny Morken agreed to be the Council liaison for this committee. Committee will meet on Thursday, October 14th to plan the activities for the year.

Stewardship – Committee is working on the correspondence letter for next year.

Evangelism-Bonnie Brisky reported that the “New Member Sunday” will be November 21st. Committee is still discussing plans for the Giving Tree. Pastor will find out what the need is from the churches that hold their services in Hanson Hall and other organizations in the community. Committee will meet to discuss ways to introduce our Church to those new in the area.

Local Mission-Food was blessed and taken to St. Matthew’s Friendship House in Immokalee and was greatly appreciated. The Friendship House volunteers are trying to find a safer way to interact with the community while observing Covid restrictions.

Worship & Music – No report

New Business:

Trunk or Treat will take place in the north parking lot of the Church on Sunday, October 31st beginning at 6:00 p.m. Cars will be decorated for Halloween, and we hope to have games planned for the little ones. We will pass out Church flyers to the adults informing them of the worship service hours and the different activities we offer during the year.

Paul Todd Christmas concert is scheduled for Monday, December 6, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. Tickets will be \$20.00 each, and the proceeds will be donated as a memorial to Carol Lyberg and all her years of service. The committee is talking with the family as to where the proceeds should be donated.

Council was adjourned at 7:15 p.m. with closing prayer by Pastor Jeff.

Next meeting will be November 9, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., with devotions by Bob Tidmore.
